Why did we choose Leaven Kids?

Leaven Kids currently operates 22 learning centers across California and Texas, where it provides after-school tutoring and educational resources to young students living in historically underserved neighborhoods. These facilities are embedded right in the apartment complexes where local children live and play, providing unparalleled access to after-school mentorship and academic programming. In total, Leaven Kids provides over 600 hours each year in after-school education, mentorship, and skill building. In some locations, the agency has recorded a 53 percent average decrease in crime within the surrounding neighborhoods and a 21 percent average increase in tenant occupancy in rental complexes that house a Leaven Kids learning center.
